CENTENNIAL COMMERORATION LOGO AND POSTER ART CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY

Only Ryan Place residents are eligible to compete. Only original artwork conceived and created by the entrant will be considered for the contest. Each entry must be accompanied with the proper form signed stating this is so.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

You must register to participate in the contest by March 31st. A registration number will be issued to you that must be on all entries. All submitted art must be labeled with the registration number and the art piece number. Example: "Reg. #1234, Art No. 1." All electronic submissions must be saved with a file name as "Reg#Art1, 2, or 3." Example: "Reg1234Art1." No lettering, signatures, or initials may appear on the front or back of the art. Any artwork with such identifying characteristics will be disqualified and eliminated from the competition.

REQUIREMENT

All art submissions *must* include the 8th Avenue Ryan Place entry column(s) and have it displayed predominantly within the piece submitted.

CENTENNIAL THEME

The theme of the centennial commemoration is "Honor the Past, Celebrate the Present, Embrace the Future."

SUBMISSION PROTOCOLS

Three pieces of artwork maybe entered for each category: Logo; or Poster. The same protocols apply for each category.

When preparing your entry please only one image per piece of paper or electronic file; 3 pieces of artwork per entry; and one entry per person, per category. All entries must be in print form and in digital form (saved on CD or Flash Drive) accompanied by an Official Entry Form. The digital file format must be TIFF or EPS. JPG will *not* be accepted. The digital file should be 300 dpi and generally be 1 MB or larger.

WHAT KIND OF ART IS ELIGIBLE?

All drawing, painting or digital art will be accepted.

Physical Artwork

Full color artwork maybe submitted, but it is RECOMMENDED that you create a design that lends itself well to being rendered down to four color, three color, grayscale, AND black and white as this makes it easier to use the design in the various mediums inexpensively and accurately (Screen Printing, Dye Sub Printing, Inkjet Printing, Web, etc.)

Any art, other than digital art, must not be smaller than 8 inches by 10 inches nor exceed 14 inches by 16 inches and must be mounted on black mount board with a 2" border.

Digital Format

- A vector-based format is recommended, but raster formats will also be accepted.
- It is recommended to use the RGB color space and not the CMYK color space.
- To guarantee the highest possible quality, it is RECOMMEND the following vector formats (in order from best to worst):
 - EPS - Encapsulated Postscript File (Vector Mode, NOT Bitmap Mode)
 - SVG - Scalable Vector Graphics
 - AI - Adobe Illustrator File
- If you do not have access to or experience with professional graphic design programs such as Adobe Illustrator or Adobe Photoshop and do not wish to purchase any specifically for this contest, we would recommend using Inkscape (found at <http://www.inkscape.org>) for Vector based formats. If you must use raster based, we recommend the GNU Image Manipulation Program aka G.I.M.P. (found at <http://www.gimp.org>) or GIMPshop (found at <http://www.gimpshop.com>), a version of GIMP tailored to people who are familiar with Adobe Photoshop. All of these programs are legal to download and use free of charge.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Entries will be judged not only on creativity and originality, but also on whether they depict the theme of the centennial commemoration.

You may submit up to three pieces, per category, for consideration. The judges will review multiple entries by the same artist and choose the piece to represent the artist in the contest. The decision of the judges is final once the judging period begins.

RIGHTS

By entering the contest, the Contestant grants to Ryan Place Improvement Association (RPIA) the following rights in perpetuity: (1) the right to publicly display the artwork at any venue deemed appropriate by RPIA and; (2) the right to photograph or otherwise reproduce the artwork for the use in connection with (i) promotional or advertising activities undertaken by RPIA; or (ii) one or more publications of the artwork; and (iii) to include the artwork in the Ryan Place Centennial time capsule.

DELIVERY

All entries must be in print form and in digital form (saved on CD or Flash Drive) accompanied by an Official Entry Form. Please place all artwork images, official entry form in one envelope. Artwork images or CDs should be labeled individually and legibly. Each piece of artwork must include the following information on the back of each hard copy: the artwork's title; and the registration number that was assigned to you. Improperly marked images will be disqualified.

When you deliver, your submissions *do not* place them in the mailbox or ring the doorbell; the door will not be answered. Place your envelope in the labeled plastic container on the side-covered porch located by the driveway.

Materials: hard copies, CDs or Flash Drives will not be returned (so have a duplicate made for your own files). RPIA will not be responsible for the loss, damage or return of any images, CDs or Flash Drives submitted to the competition.

DEADLINE

All entries must be delivered no later than April 30, 2010, 6:00 pm.

JUDGING

All properly prepared entries will be viewed and judged. The decision of the judges is final.

JUDGES

A panel of judges will select a first, second, and third place winner in each category: Logo or Poster.

NOTIFICATION

Semi finalist will be notified by email and by phone on May 15, 2010.

The winner will be announced during the Ryan Place Memorial Street Dance on Saturday, May 29, 2010, attendance is not required.

The results will not otherwise be made public until they are published in the June Ryan Place Newsletter. Non-winning entrants will not be individually notified of the results.
